

This Coast Guard approved, hands-on course covers survival theory using visual aids, in-the-water exercises with immersion suits, man-overboard retrieval devices, an inflatable life raft and an array of other survival gear. Instruction includes survival-at-sea techniques, search and rescue procedures, and treatment of hypothermia. Hands-on training covers signaling devices, man-overboard and abandon-ship emergencies, and cold-water survival techniques.

Bring your own working lunch, drinks and snacks. Bring working attire suitable for in water portions of the class (swimwear, towel, light wetsuit if you get cold).
