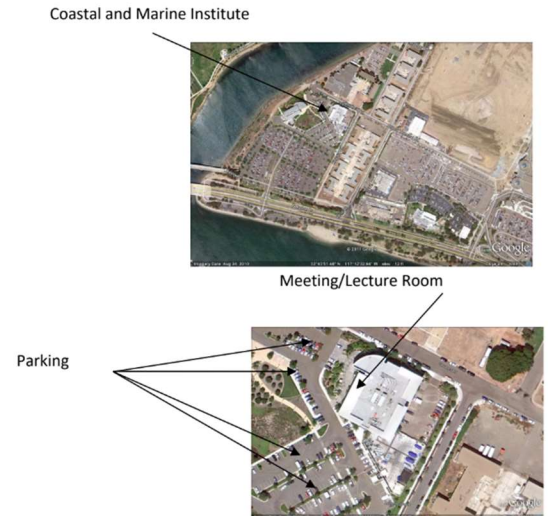

Wrap around to the NW side of the building and park. The lecture room is also on the NW side of the building, look for the large open door with dive flags.

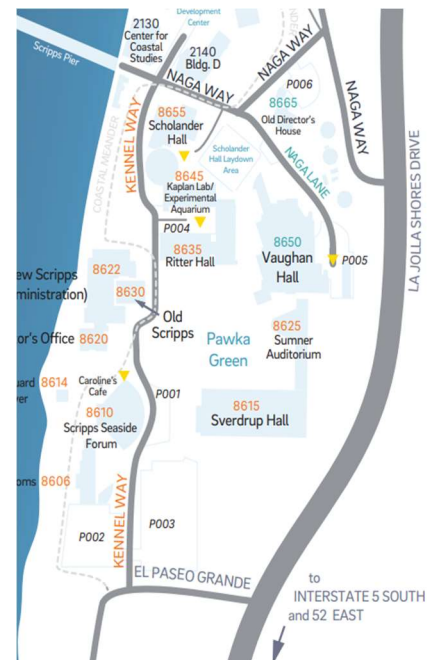

Overview

Self Propelled Boating as a widely employed method of Scientific Boating that presents a unique set of operational considerations and risk mitigation strategies. This half day workshop is based on The Nature Conservancy's Self Propelled Boating safety course, and will highlight safety standards, as well as in water skills and rescue techniques. This course is designed for individuals that are familiar with paddle craft operation, to develop leadership strategies and group management techniques that are applicable to scientific boating programs.

Logistics

This training will be hosted by SBSA at Aqua Adventures, Mission Bay ([Aqua Adventures](#)). Activities will involve work from Kayaks, including, simulated rescues - immersion in temperate water is to be expected (~55-65 degrees average water temperature during this time of year). Kayak rental will be arranged through Aqua Adventures, however, **participants are responsible for providing their own exposure protection gear** appropriate for this environment (ie; wetsuit or kayak drysuit). Wetsuits rental can be arranged through [Ocean Enterprises](#) in San Diego, as needed.
